CLASSES

Class 1: Eventers challenge – mixed height up to maximum of (60cm ((2ft)) £20

Class 2: Eventers challenge – mixed heights up to a maximum of (85cm ((2ft 9)) £20

The heights in all XC phases are a maximum; the course will include fences below this height.

Closing date for entries will be Wednesday 24th August, times will published on our website www.reinandshine.co.uk and our facebook page.

How does Eventers Challenge work?

This is a two Phase horse trial:

- The first section is over show jumps and the second is timed over cross country fences.
- The show jump phase will be approx. 10 jumps, followed immediately by 10-12 cross country jumps.

After the show jumps competitors can warm up in the cross country designated warm up area and will be called into the start box by the judge ready to begin. The cross country phase will be timed, Overall the winner and runners up will be those that achieve clear round in both phases with the fastest time over the cross county phase.

Start times will be allocated to all competitors.

NB. At this event, if you are eliminated SJ, we may allow you to continue onto XC at the judges discretion, but anyone eliminated XC will have to leave the course at a walk allowing others to continue safely.

Eventers Challenge: £20 per class

All shows will be attended by a First Aider. First aid charges are included within the class entry fees. Late entries may be accepted at the discretion of the Show Secretary, late entries will incur an additional £2 late entry charge per class.

Medical armbands and back protectors are compulsory. Competitors must provide their own number bibs and medical armbands. Without these competitors cannot compete

Course Walking

The courses will be available to walk from 2pm the day before the competition.

Terms & Conditions

1. If you are eliminated in the SJ round you may (at the judge's discretion be able to go on HC into the next phase but will not be placed)
2. A horse/pony may only be entered in one class and ridden once, the only exception to this is that a horse / pony may compete in a second class with a second rider.

All horses/ponies must be 5 years old or over. No stallions.

3. MEDICAL ARMBANDS and BODY PROTECTORS are compulsory for cross-country and body protectors are advised for show jumping. Riders wearing body cages must leave a key with the secretary before going cross country.
4. A fastened hat must be worn at all times when mounted . Please ensure you are wearing a hat that conforms to the 2016 standards. If in doubt, please refer to the Pony club website http://www.pcuk.org/uploads/dcs/Hat_Rule_2016_FV.pdf . All hats must be tagged as conforming to the pony club / Riding Club standards. This will be checked before the dressage – take any untagged hats to the secretary beforehand. There will be a charge of £1 for hats to be tagged. A fastened hat must be worn at all times when mounted.
5. Any competitor who has a fall or sustains a serious injury anywhere at the competition site must see medical personnel on the day and be passed fit to ride before riding that horse in a further test

or before riding any other horse. Any competitor having a fall injury needs to report to the Secretary to have the fall logged in the Accident log.

6. Objections may be lodged, in writing, to the Secretary with a £10 deposit within 10 minutes of the publication of the results for that class.

7. Excessive use of whip or spurs will result in disqualification, the judge's decision is final.

8. All withdrawals must be made by the closing date. Entries are not refundable. Later cancellations received by the Show Secretary will not be refunded or transferred, including on-the-day entries.

9. All dogs must be kept on a short lead.

10. Please do not muck out lorries/trailers in the car park and take all litter home.

11. The Judges decision is final.

12. Health, safety and welfare: The organisers have taken all reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of everyone present at this event. For these measures to be effective, everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents. They must obey the instructions of the organisers and all officials and stewards.

13. Legal liability: Save for the death or personal injury caused by the negligence of the organisers, or anyone for whom they are in law responsible, neither the organisers of this event or The Pony Club/ The Riding Club nor any agent, employee or representative of these bodies, nor the landlord or his tenant, accepts any liability for any accident, loss, damage, injury or illness to horses, owners, riders, spectators, land, cars, their contents and accessories, or any other personal property whatsoever, whether caused by their negligence, breach of contract or in any other way whatsoever. Entries are only accepted on this basis.
